1.- ELCIRA'S WEBSITE

In late August 2012, WP7 started the process that led to the creation of the ELCIRA informative website. After discussing with the project partners the navigation map and the intention of creating a website devoted to inform about the project existence and advancements, in mid September the website started to be developed and was officially launched in October 3, 2012.

The website was hosted on a Linux server, under the CPANEL platform for sites, where is located an account for its administration. Since this is an informative website, not a transactional one, with a low rotation of content, there are no tools implemented for sharing information and the updating is developed directly through a file transfer protocol (FTP).

2.- WEBSITE OBJECTIVES

-To support the work developed by the project members in order to achieve the main objective of the project focus in providing an interoperability framework that facilitates the work of European-Latin American research teams and to foster collaboration in joint research projects.

- To enhance and propitiate the use of collaborative tools that straighten the collaborative work and the academic and research activities.
