6. DEVELOPED MATERIAL

To increase the visibility of the project among the research communities ELCIRA has participated in scientific events that had taken place in The Netherlands, Colombia, Mexico and Lithuania. Each one of these events required the production of specific material to be displayed and delivered during the activities. In the following sections the details of the conferences and ELCIRA's participation on them are given (obviously in what is referred to dissemination material) .

6.1. TNC2013

On June 3rd to 6th in the city of Maastricht in The Netherlands took place the TERENA Networking Conference, TNC2013. In order to provide information about the work carried out within the project and to invite the members of the research communities to participate in the initiative, 100 brochures in English were displayed in the stand of the pan-European network GÉANT (Figure 1), project member.

In addition to the ELCIRA brochures, a project roller banner (Figure 2) was placed inside the GÉANT booth and a poster about the project was located in the exhibition area (Figure 3).

6.2. TICAL2013

In July 8th and 9th 2013, ELCIRA was part of the Third TICAL Conference developed in Cartagena de Indias, Colombia. TICAL2013 gathered more than 300 participants involved in topics related to Research, Education, Collaboration, Governance of ICT and e-Infrastructure.

During TICAL2013, ELCIRA had an informative booth (Figure 4) located at the entrance of the plenary sessions. Because of the participants of TICAL are basically Latin American researchers and academics, it was produce a Spanish version of the brochure (Figure 1), and 500 units were distributed during the two days of activities. In addition 250 highlighter pens with ELCIRA's logo printed were distributed among the visitors (Figure 5).

A roller banner (Figure 2) and two sticky banners for the upper structure of the booth were also part of it.

6.3. AUTUMN MEETING OF CUDI/AMERICAS CONFERENCE

In October 2nd and 4th 2013, the city of Campeche in Mexico was the venue of two events: the 28 biannual reunion of CUDI and the AMERICAS EU-LAC ICT & e-Infrastructures Conference.

In both activities ELCIRA participated with an informative booth (Figure 6) with the participation of members of the WP7 and WP5. According to the website of the Conference, the Autumn Meeting of CUDI involve the participation of 390 people of 104 educational and research institutions and companies related with the Mexican NREN.

For this event 350 USB devices (Figure 7) were produced, 250 were delivered during this conference and 150 were delivered in ICT2013 (details of this activity will be given later in this document). Moreover 200 ELCIRA brochures in Spanish were distributed among the participants.

For the setup of the stand were printed two roller banners (Figure 2) and sticky-banners to be placed in the frontal desk of the booth (Figure 6). The ELCIRA poster was also translated into Spanish and displayed in the stand.

6.4. ICT2013

In November 6th to 8th 2013 ELCIRA participated in the ICT2013 Conference that took place in Vilnius, Lithuania. For this event ELCIRA had to applied in an open call released on June 2013 which received more than 270 proposals and that resulted in 185 projects selected to showcase the latest findings in advanced research, technologies, new systems, innovation in services and business and ICT products just coming to market. The ELCIRA project was one of them.

The ICT2013 event was organised by the European Commission in partnership with the Lithuanian Presidency of the Council of the EU, and the official sponsors of the Presidency. According to the event website ICT2013 received 5315 participants from all over the world.

During the three days of activities, the stand of ELCIRA was part of the International Village dome and in it were distributed 600 brochures, 100 USB memories with information about the Project (Figure 7), 1000 laser points and highlighters pens, and 600 highlighters markers (Figure 5), all with the ELCIRA brand on them.
